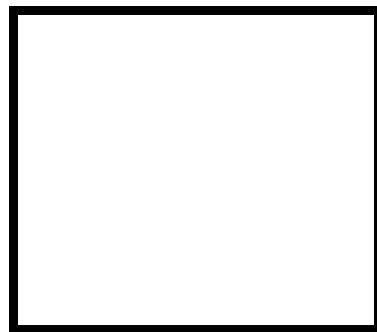

POINTS SYSTEM

There are 5 rounds. You are awarded double points for the Championship round, best 4 rounds to count for the league, which means that to qualify you have to do either.

- 1 – The Championship round (which counts double) plus a minimum of 2 other rounds, or
- 2 – If you miss the Championship round you would have to do all the other 4.

In each round, 50 points will be awarded for 1st place, 49 points for 2nd, 48 points for 3rd and so on. For the Championship Round, the winner would get 100 points, 2nd place 98, 3rd place 96 etc. The winner of each category will be the athlete with the highest points total from their best 4 races (or 3 including the Championship Round) at the end of the series.
